

JUNE SUNDAY SCHOOL WITH REV. MARK CLARK: "Law & Religion in the U.S." Over the past several years, the U.S. Supreme Court has altered the legal landscape so that traditional values such as the importance of protecting the rights of minorities and the separation of church and state have been called into question. For instance, is a public-school teacher now permitted to lead students in prayer? May a shop owner lawfully refuse to sell goods to someone because of their sexual

orientation? May taxpayers be compelled to support private religious schools no matter its curriculum or admission policies? Join Mark Clark on four Sundays in June as he discusses these and other recent cases that are impacting our country. The class will meet in Room 6 from 9:00-10:00 a.m. Mark Clark is a retired lawyer and minister in the PC(USA). He is on the adjunct faculty at the UALR Bowen School of Law where he teaches courses on Law & Religion and Reproductive Rights. He is married to the Rev. Carol Clark, currently the pastor at the Park Hill Presbyterian Church in North Little Rock.
